ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Delhi Library Board and in supersession of earlier Recruitment Rules in respect of posts in the DPL except as respects things done or omitted to have been done before such supersession, the Competent Authority hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'A', 'B' & 'C' level posts in the DPL:-

1. **Short title and commencement:** - These Rules may be called the Delhi Library Board Recruitment Rules (Group 'A,'B' Gazetted Level and Group 'B' Non-Gazetted & 'C' level posts) 2019. They shall come into force on the date of issue of the Order.
2. **Name of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale:-** The name of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached to these said posts shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule of each post as annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to these said posts, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (12) of the respective Schedule of each post.
4. **Disqualification – No person**
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax** – Where the Delhi Library Board is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.
6. **Saving** – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxations of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen, Departmental candidates and other Special Categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


